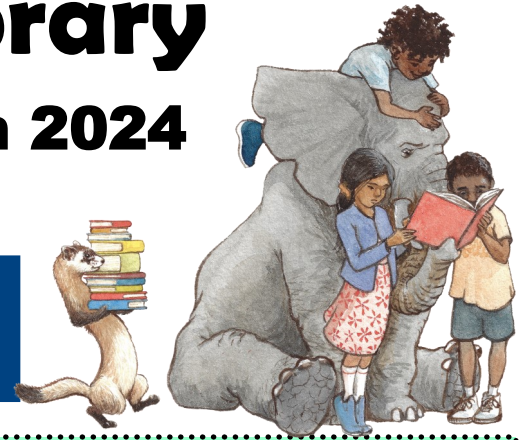

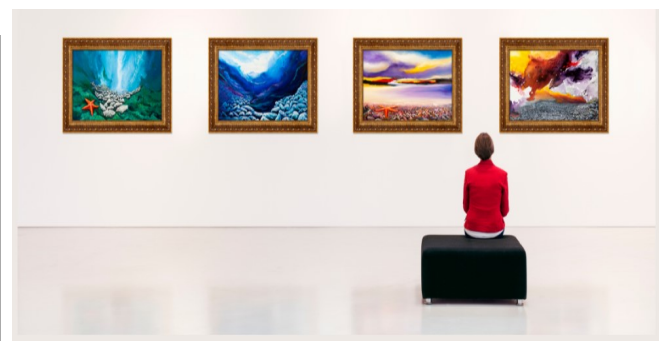
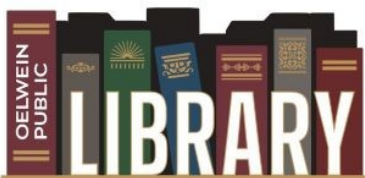
Check out our Juneteenth Display. Earn a Summer Reading Program prize ticket by filling out a Juneteenth trivia sheet. One per participant, please.

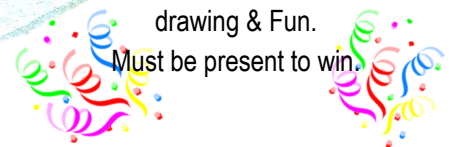
Meet the Iowa Honey Princess
