What does IR mean? Immersive Reality. When you check out one of these books, you will also be given cardboard goggles to use. Goggles must return with

the book. Down load the app to your cell phone. Place phone inside cardboard goggles. At three different points in the book, scan the QR codes and the experience related to the book will automatically download.
