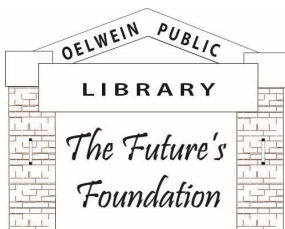

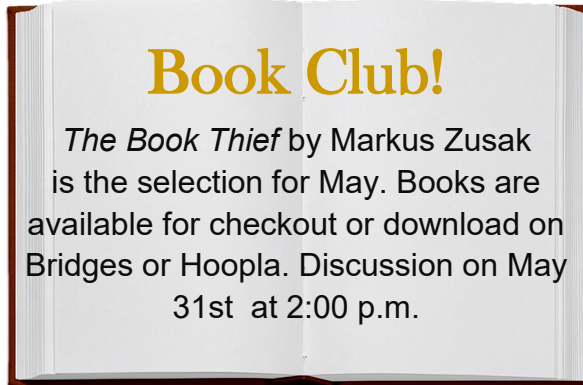

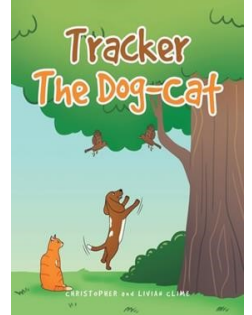

This book tells the story of hound dog that loves to explore and learn. He meets a neighborhood cat and decides to try the cat life for a day.

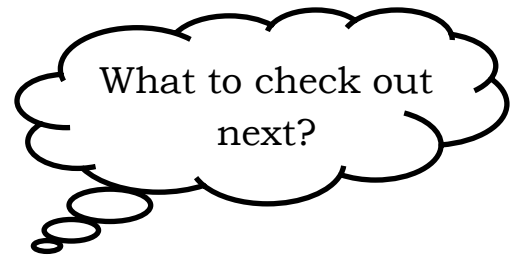


**Cookbook Book Club – stop by the library to pick up your cookbook (or in this case, magazine)!**

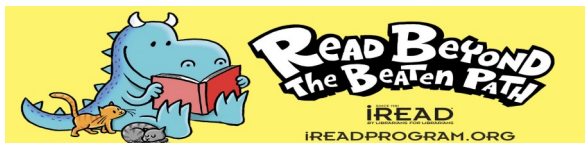
